



# Divorce Lawyer Advice for when you can't locate your ex-partner to serve divorce papers

Service is the sending or giving of filed court documents to the opposing party. Proof of service of the divorce application is one of the procedural requirements asserted by the court that must be complied with in order for the court to grant the divorce.

## What options exist if you cannot serve the divorce application on your former spouse?

Once you have made all reasonable attempts to serve the divorce application, you may seek the assistance of a divorce lawyer who can apply to the court for either substituted service or dispensation of service.

Substituted service allows you to serve the documents on a third party who the Court is satisfied will bring those documents the attention of your former spouse.

Dispensation of service is where the Court is satisfied that you have made all reasonable attempts to locate your spouse in attempt to serve the divorce application, and as a result the Court says that you do not need to serve the documents.

## Why should you seek assistance from a divorce lawyer?

In order to apply to the Court for substituted or dispensation of service, you must complete an application in a case and an affidavit. Your application will need to set out all the attempts you made to locate your former spouse. Such details to be included in this supporting affidavit may consist of:

- Details of all attempts to make enquiries to locating the other party
- When you last saw or communicated with them
- The last known address
- Their nearest relatives and friends and any enquiries you made with these people
- Their employment and any enquiries you made with the employer
- Details of any property owned by the other party
- If they reside overseas details of the country, duration of their time there and future plans if known
- Any known reasons why they are not contactable
- Cost difficulties in locating them
- Any other relevant information
